We will be singing Feel the Spirit!, which we are singing for our November concert, and a medley from Les Misérables. Our accompanist will be Ken Forster, and Emily Robinson will be joining us for the afternoon to sing the solos in Feel the Spirit. The cost for the day will be £20, but

we hope our members will appreciate that this is a social occasion as well as a useful rehearsal for our autumn concert. The booking form is attached.

Because our autumn concert is so early this year, rehearsals will begin on **Tuesday 16th August**. Geoff's Tuesday afternoon sessions at Beetham Church have begun, and there were 12 at the first one, which was extremely useful. If you'd like to come along you're very welcome – we're charging £3 per person per session to cover Geoff's fee, which we will collect at the start of term. We start at 3.30pm.
